F-15 BEDDOWN AND INFRASTRUCTURE UPGRADES AT ANDERSEN AFB, GUAM



The United States Department of the Air Force (DAF) invites you to participate in public scoping for the F-15 Beddown and Infrastructure Upgrades at Andersen Air Force Base (AFB) Environmental Impact Statement.

What: The DAF proposes to beddown and support the mission of 12 Republic of Singapore Air Force F-15 fighter aircraft; and construct new infrastructure upgrades adjacent to the northwest corner of the airfield and within the munitions storage area at Andersen AFB, Guam.

When: A 30-day public scoping period is being held, beginning with the publication of the Notice of Intent in the Federal Register, which is anticipated to occur on or around December 15, 2024.

Why: The DAF is conducting an additional public scoping period to update the public on changes to the project proposal that have occurred since the initial scoping period was conducted in 2021. The DAF will be accepting comments under NEPA and will also accept comments under Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act (36 Code of Federal Regulations Part 800) regarding the identification of or effects on historic properties and requests to become a consulting party in the Section 106 process.
